- Diverse partners: City of Chicago, ONE Northside, Garfield Park Community Council
- Identified properties, assigned to risk buckets
- Analyze owners: current & prospective
- New financing tool



PASSED! Property Tax Incentive

Compact partners lead legislative effort

- Housing Action Illinois, IHC, MPC, and Enterprise
- State legislation
 - 35% affordability: 35% relief
 - 15% affordability: 25% relief
 - 20% affordability downtown: tiered relief

Diverse neighborhood impact

- Investment in lower-cost neighborhoods
- Affordability in rising-cost neighborhoods



PASSED! New Plumbing Code

Code Improvements

- Pilot Plumbing Program
 - Saved over \$38 million for Chicago property owners
- New plumbing code allows PVC
 - PVC allowed in residential buildings up to 60 feet in height
 - Includes residential areas of mixed-use buildings
 - Code Interpretation for PVC in mixed-use buildings
 - 2021 Amendments to the Plumbing Code
